Gross Japanese Candy List

#1 – Black Black Hard Candy



The packaging says “**High Technical Excellent Taste**”, and by that they mean this candy was meant for robots without taste-buds.

For anyone WITH taste buds, this tar-textured hard candy is like sucking a **(Ricola x Infinity) + Hate**

#2 – Green Tea Sucking Hard Candy



Imagine someone poured a **stale cup of green tea in a dirty puddle on a busy city street**, scooped it up, and turned it into a sucker candy. That’s kind of what this is like.

#3 – Magic Spice Curry Soup Chew



I *really* double checked, and made sure this wasn't just a soup bouillon. It is a spicy sweet curry candy, which is marketed as “**100% Edible**”. It's interesting that the seller felt the need to describe it that way.

#4 – Poppin' Cookin' Sushi Candy

#7 – Puccha Cola Chew



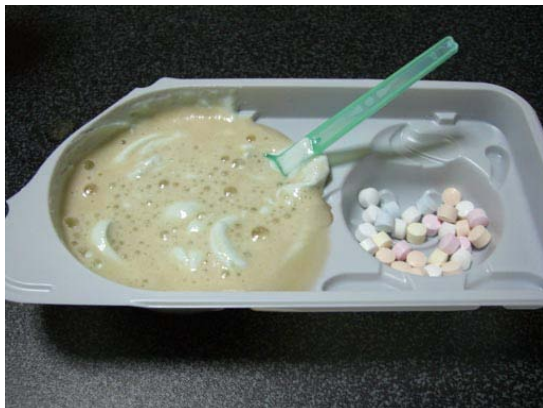
So it's like a starburst candy. Yum.
